ASV 2023 Ann Palmenberg Junior Investigator Award

Details for eligibility

- Last degree within 10 years of the nomination deadline
- Must have an independent position
- Previous nominees that did not receive an Ann Palmenberg Junior Investigator Award may be nominated for the 2023 award.
- Previous recipients of the Ann Palmenberg Junior Investigator Award may not be nominated again.

Nomination package submitted by nominator

1. Nomination must be submitted by a current full member of ASV.
2. Nominee's Biographical Sketch using this [template](#).
3. Nominee's contact information.
4. A nomination letter *that includes the nominator email address*.
5. Submit as an electronic submission of a single collated PDF (Items 2 - 4) to asv@asv.org, with the subject line: Nomination for ASV Junior Investigator Award.

Deadline: November 18, 2022

- \$1,000 cash award presented at the ASV 2023 meeting
- ASV 2023 Registration, accommodation, and travel expenses will be covered by the Society
- Engraved plaque
- 15-minute research talk to be scheduled in one of the morning Symposia at the 2023 ASV Annual Meeting, June 24-28, 2023, at the Classic Center in Athens, Georgia.

Decisions and Announcements:

The ASV Council will review all nominations to identify awardees. The nominee's contributions to virology will be evaluated based on the nomination letter and the biographical sketch.

Awardees will be notified before the February 1, 2023 abstract submission deadline. ASV members will learn of their colleagues' awards at the ASV 2023 meeting.
